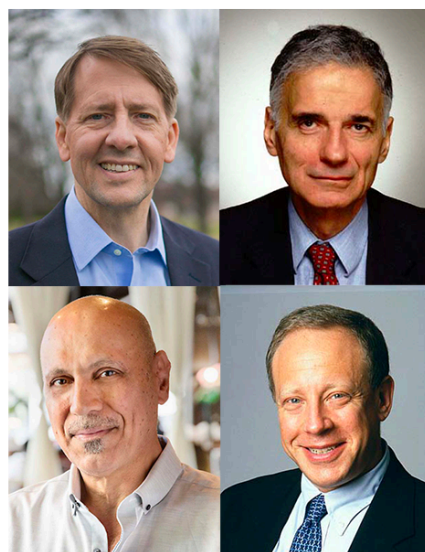

Restoring Civility and Bringing Social Justice to American Life: A virtual brunch and talk

A special event featuring four lifelong advocates for social justice as they share their vision of a more just, egalitarian and united America.

Featuring **Richard Cordray**, former director of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau under President Obama, and **Ralph Nader**, legendary consumer advocate—named by *Time*, *Life* and *Atlantic* magazines as one of the 100 most influential people in American history—in conversation with **Carl Mayer**. Special guest **Andy Shallal** will prepare dishes from Mr. Nader's recently released cookbook.



Richard Cordray's new book, **Watchdog**, outlines how the bureau acted quickly to protect consumers from ill-doing by the financial services industry. Nader's latest book is **The Nader Family Cookbook**, which shares the cuisine of his Lebanese upbringing, presenting both popular and lesser-known dishes as well as stories about how his parents taught him social justice in the kitchen. Shallal, founder of Busboys and Poets, will prepare select dishes from Nader's cookbook.

Purchase a copy of the cookbook and cook along during this 90-minute discussion where no topic will be off limits and participants can question each speaker.
