Public Comment

Public comment will be allowed during the Public Comment portion of the meeting only. Comments containing offensive, profane or indecent language or language constituting hate speech, will not be accepted.

Prior to the Meeting

Comments may be sent to pplpubliccomment@princetonlibrary.org until 2:30 p.m. on April 17 and will be read aloud at the meeting.

During the meeting

Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes in duration (this applies to written public comments submitted via email that are read aloud). Members of the public will be asked if they wish to comment and will be asked to identify themselves when it is their turn to comment.

A disruptive member of the public will be muted and warned that continued disruption may result in their being prevented from speaking or removed from the meeting. Disruptive conduct includes shouting, interruption and use of profanity. If an individual continues to be disruptive after the initial warning, they may be muted while public comment continues. If time permits, the disruptive individual shall be allowed to speak after all others have been given the opportunity to make their comment. Should the person remain disruptive, the individual may be muted or kept on mute for the remainder of the meeting or removed from the remote public meeting.
